Information for Students

Financial Terms and Conditions

Agreement

This document sets out the financial terms and conditions for enrolment and attendance at City Harvest Training Center (CHTC).

These terms and conditions reflect the CHTC current fee policy. All students are required to adhere to these terms and conditions.

Please read the following carefully, and signify your agreement by clicking “Yes” in the relevant box on the Enrolment Form. Please note that you will not be enrolled in CHTC until we have received your agreement to these financial terms and conditions.

If you are unsure of any of these financial terms and conditions, or have any concerns, please do not hesitate to contact the City Harvest Church office for further details and discussion.

Payment of Fees

Fees are payable in advance and are not refundable except in special circumstances (contained in the “Refunds & Overdue Payments” policy below and in the Student Handbook). All fees are expressed and payable in US Dollars.

CHTC tuition fees, Sundry Charges and all other fees are contained in the “*Schedule of Fees and Charges*” ([attached](#)) and on the CHTC Website. For more detailed information, please do not hesitate to contact the City Harvest Church office.

Upon acceptance of enrolment, each student will then be sent an Invoice which details the fees payable for their course.

Tuition fees must be paid in one of two ways:

1. Each Semester in advance; or
2. The Registration Fee and the monthly payment option due on the 3rd day of each month.

The following conditions will apply:

- Payment for the full term is required prior to attendance at the first class. Students will not be permitted to attend class unless the fees are up-to-date;
- Students are liable for the full term’s fees, even if they should withdraw before the end of term.
- Late payment of fees (i.e. after the first day of term or payment due date) will result in a \$100 late fee.
- Refunds will be given in limited circumstances (see “Refunds & Overdue Payments” policy below and in the Student Handbook.)
- Full payment of fees can be paid by in full by Electronic Transfer, cash, check or credit card. Checks should be made payable to “Derek Dunn Ministries”. For the monthly payment options, the auto-pay must be set up for Credit Card or ACH.

Suspension for Non-Payment of Fees

CHTC reserves the right to suspend any student from class for non-payment of fees. Suspension may be for a limited period or may even result in removal from College altogether in extreme circumstances. Any suspension will only take place after sufficient warnings have been given to the student and in accordance with CHTC discipline policies contained in the Student Handbook.

Refunds and Overdue Payments

1. If you do not commence classes in CHTC you will be refunded all tuition fees you have paid in relation to that course.
2. Fees are non-refundable should a student change their mind during the year. However, there is a **cooling off period of the first 2 weeks of first term**. If a student decides that the course does not meet their needs and withdraws during that time, they will not be liable for the term's fees. Please note that withdrawal must be in accordance with the "Withdrawal from CHTC" policies in the Student Handbook.
3. Students in the CHTC who withdraw after this cooling off period will be liable for any outstanding tuition fees and Sundry Charges for the current term.
4. Graduation is conditional upon payment of fees in full. Students with any fees (including late fees) unpaid at the end of the Semester will not graduate and CHTC will charge interest on the outstanding balance. This will apply until outstanding fees and accrued interest are paid.
5. Students who are forced to discontinue for medical or compassionate reasons may apply for exemption from this condition in accordance with the CHTC policies in the Student Handbook.
6. Any requests for a refund should be submitted in writing to the CHTC office.

Sundry Charges

Students will be liable for Sundry Charges where applicable. These are not tuition fees, but discretionary charges where students have used CHTC services or equipment. No student will be charged a sundry item without prior notice. Sundry charges include:

- Photocopying and faxing
- Late tuition payment Fee
- Equipment damage costs

Please note that the costs for these Sundry Charges are contained in the "Schedule of Fees and Charges" (attached) or can be obtained from CHTC office.

Student Activity Fee

In addition to the Tuition Fees and any other Sundry Charges, all full-time, on campus students are also required to pay any Mission Trip Fee ("MTF") should they opt to go for any optional missions trips. These trips are not included in the tuition fee. Any MTF fees will be communicated in advance and the students may determine whether they want to participate.

Fee Discounts

The following discounts are available to CHTC students:

- \$200 discount on tuition fees for students who pay Fees in full before the commencement of the Academic Year.

Fee Disputes

CHTC's dispute resolution process is available to you if you wish to dispute any aspect of CHTC application of its fee policy. In pursuing such a dispute, you should first approach the Dean with your case documented in writing, providing as much detail as possible. The Dean will then consider your request, in consultation with the Principal and advise you of the decision. If this is not resolved to your satisfaction, then you can follow the Complaints Policy in the Student Handbook to seek a resolution. This agreement, and the availability of CHTC's complaints and appeals processes, does not remove the right of the student to take further action under consumer protection or any other relevant laws.

IN-PERSON COURSES YEAR 1

GOING ON TO PERFECTION

Once you have laid the basic foundation truths in your life, how can you now grow into spiritual maturity? In this module, you will be introduced to the Tabernacle of Moses. As we learn about the significance and symbolism of various areas and each piece of furniture, you will be amazed to see God's plan for redemption and sanctification unfold powerfully in your life, and you will be on your way, not just to become a stronger Christian, but also to grow into the fullness of Jesus Christ.

CULTURAL MANDATE I (Theology & Concepts)

When God created man and put him in the Garden of Eden, He gave him the responsibility "to tend and keep it" (Gen. 2:15). In Latin, that is the word *cultura* from which the English word "culture" is derived. Long before the Great Commandment and the Great Commission were given, man was entrusted with the Cultural Mandate, to create and do culture in the world that God had placed him in. But doing culture involves engaging a broken-down, fallen world, with all its immorality, greed and temptations. How can we do that without losing our conviction and consecration? How do we bring Christ into culture when we are supposed to be separated from everything worldly? Is innocence or naivety a Christian virtue that preserves purity? In this first instalment of a 2-module series, you will learn about the theology and important concepts of the Cultural Mandate.

CULTURAL MANDATE II Cultural Mandate 2 (Relevance & Influence)

Eminent theologian John Stott calls this the "Great Paradox of Holiness", that the God who has saved us and sets us apart is now sending us into a sinful and fallen world. Stott says that every church and every Christian must know how to walk in "holy worldliness" — a holiness that is not unworldly, and a worldliness that is not unholy. Holy worldliness is the intentional living of the life of God in a broken-down world, amidst a fallen people. Engaging culture will invariably involve the marketplace of society, especially in the realm of popular culture (or "pop culture"). As Christians, how should we handle and engage the arenas of music, movies, novels, fashion, sports, arts and entertainment? How do we practically usher in the character and presence of God in a postmodern world that seems to be against anything moral or godly? In this second instalment of a 2-module series, you will learn what the practical aspects of the Cultural Mandate are.

MINISTRY PRACTICUM

This course is a "hands on" servant-hood class in which students serve practically in the community sharing the love of Jesus, not only in word but in deed. Students serve in various other locations and organizations in the Church and local community. Through practical experience you will grow in skill and ability to interact with others outside of your comfort zone which will equip you in better serving others as well as in the marketplace.

IN-PERSON COURSES YEAR 2

SERMON ON THE MOUNT 1 (Beatitudes)

The Sermon on the Mount is the most famous and powerful exposition Jesus had ever preached. The three chapters from Matthew 5-7 may take only 10 minutes to read through, but a lifetime to study, understand and live out. In SOTM 1 (Beatitudes), you will learn about the attitudes of the kingdom. Your attitudes are the "heart" within your heart. It is the real you! Your attitudes are so sacred that no one (not even God!) can overrule it. It is the most genuine expression of your perspective about God and of your love for God. In this course, we will see Jesus outlining the eight kingdom attitudes that will guarantee the approval and blessings of God in our lives.

SERMON ON THE MOUNT 2 (Kingdom Righteousness)

St. Augustine described the Sermon on the Mount as “a perfect standard for the Christian life”. Dietrich Bonhoeffer’s classic, *The Cost of Discipleship*, is based on this sermon. Martin Lloyd-Jones’ greatest life work was the *Studies in the Sermon on the Mount*. In SOTM 2 (Kingdom Righteousness), you will learn what it means to be salt and light, and Jesus’ definition of righteousness in God’s kingdom. You will understand what Jesus means when He wanted believers to exceed “the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees”. You will cover issues concerning anger, divorce and remarriage, and the inner righteousness God wants to see in the hearts of Christians.

SERMON ON THE MOUNT 3 (Kingdom Living)

If one truly embraces and understands the Sermon on the Mount, one will never embrace shallow or superficial Christianity ever again. In SOTM 3 (**Kingdom Living**), you will get into the mind of Jesus Christ on His thinking regarding genuine kingdom living. How could your devotion and spiritual discipline bring the approval and blessings of God? You will understand the consequences of the decisions and actions we make in life.
